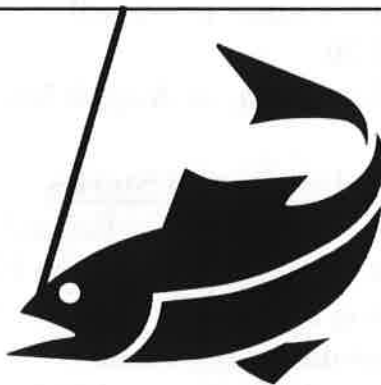

Garbage and Recycling Reminders

Reminding everyone that garbage container lids have to be completely shut or the City of Shell Rock has instructed Jendro Sanitation to not pick up the garbage. Shell Rock has a pay as you throw garbage ordinance in effect and that is why the lids have to be closed on the garbage containers. If you have garbage that does not fit in the container, City Hall sells garbage tags that go on the top of extra garbage bags for \$1.75 per tag. The garbage bags with the tags on, can be set beside or on top of the garbage containers and will be picked up by Jendro Sanitation along with the garbage in the closed container.

Items for recycling are:

Cardboard

Paper, newspaper, magazines (no shredded paper in recycling container)

Tin cans

Plastic #1-5, & 7

Clear glass—glass must be put in a separate container outside of your recycling container

The lid on the recycling container does not have to be closed. If you have extra recycling you may place it beside your recycling container or you may haul it to the City's recycling center located at 926 N. Public Rd.—behind the Butler County Maintenance Building or to the Butler County Solid Waste Commission located at 25251 Highway 3 East, Allison, Iowa. The recycling center and the Butler County Solid Waste Commission take shredded paper. The Butler County Solid Waste Commission also takes Styrofoam.



Golf Carts in the City Limits

Golf carts may be operated upon City streets by persons possessing a valid driver's license. A golf cart shall not be operated on a City street that is a primary road extension (including State highways), but shall be allowed to cross over a City street that is a primary road extension through the City. The golf cart shall be equipped with adequate brakes, a slow moving vehicle sign, and a bicycle safety flag. The golf cart may be operated on the streets only from sunrise to sunset.

Each golf cart operated on City streets shall have attached to the right rear of the golf cart a permit obtained from the City of Shell Rock at an annual fee of \$25.00. The owner of the golf cart has to have liability insurance covering the golf cart in the same limits required of automobiles. A golf cart permit may be revoked by action of the Council or the Sheriff's Department for unsafe usage or violation of traffic laws.

A person operating a golf cart shall not ride other than on a permanent regular seat attached thereto. No golf cart shall be used to carry more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed and equipped.

Golf carts may be operated on City streets only when the temperature is above 32 degrees Fahrenheit and ice and snow are not present on the street.
