Four free mini libraries can now be found around Shell Rock at the Emergency Services Building, swimming pool, Willowtree Subdivision and Holley Park. These libraries were part of Peter Holden's Boy Scout Eagle Project and were constructed and installed with the help of Shell Rock Boy Scout Troop 1051.

How these libraries work:

These libraries belong to everyone! Anyone may use it-neighbors, friends and passersby. The books are always free.

Take Books - If you see something you'd like to read, take it! It's for you. Some books include a note about who gave it or has read it. You may leave your own note in it when you're done.

Share Book - When you're finished with a book, you may pass it along to a friend or return it to any Little Free Library.

Leave Books - Your books are welcome at any Little Free Library. If your local Library is full, there may be another Library nearby that could use them. Especially desired are books you recommend to friends, your childhood favorites, and books that teach and spark conversation.

These libraries are sponsored by the Shell Rock Book Review Club and will be maintained by its current members and are registered with the LittleFreeLibrary.org nonprofit organization.
