

Regular Meeting Shell Rock City Council
June 7, 2016

Mayor Larry Young called the regular meeting to order in the new City Hall located at 802 N. Public Road at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members Donald Bonzer, Benjamin DeWitt, James DeWitt, Mike Klinefelter, and Rosalee Meyer were present. There were seven people in the audience.

Motion by James DeWitt seconded by Meyer to approve the agenda with any additions. Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Motion by Benjamin DeWitt seconded by Bonzer to approve the consent agenda that included: Minutes of the May 3, 2016 meeting, Payment of the bills, Financial reports for the month of April, 2016, Liquor License with Sunday Sales for the Riverview Café, and the Beer Permit with Sunday Sales for the Shell Rock 4th of July Committee. Roll Call Vote: Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Motion by Klinefelter seconded by Meyer to upgrade the telephone system in the City Hall with the estimate supplied from the Dumont Telephone Company of \$2,860.62. Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Motion by James DeWitt seconded by Benjamin DeWitt to approve partial pay estimate #7 for the Shell Rock Emergency Services Building in the amount of \$90,231.47 to Modern Builders, Inc. Roll Call Vote: Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried. Council directed Public Works Director Mike Tellinghuisen to study the possibility of installing curb and gutter in front of the Emergency Services Building.

It was reported that in two weeks the new sign for the City Hall/Police Department/Public Services Department should be in and be installed.

The tree donated by the WSR Class of 2013 in memory of Kaleb Lehman has been planted in McCague Memorial Park.

Police Chief Lou Staudt discussed radio problems with the council since moving into the new building. Chief Staudt will get estimates on installing a new antenna on the building.

Members of the Shell Rock 4th of July Committee were present and asked the council for permission on closing certain streets for the celebration. Motion by Meyer seconded by Bonzer to close the 200 and 300 blocks of S. Cherry and half of the 100 blocks of E. and W. Washington from noon on June 30 through the end of the day July 4th and part of E. Jackson Street on July 3rd and allowing Chief Staudt to close the bridge over the Shell Rock River during the fireworks on July 3rd. Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried.

The parking on Cherry Street adjacent to the Riverview Café was discussed and there was a request to have parking lines painted in front of the empty lots next to the Riverview Café on S. Cherry Street. Public Works Director Mike Tellinghuisen will evaluate the parking and paint lines per city and state guidelines.

Terry Arends from the Chrome Cruisers Car Club was present and asked the council for permission to close the 200 and 300 block of S. Cherry Street on June 12, 2016 for the annual car show. Motion by Bonzer seconded by Klinefelter to allow the 200 and 300 block of S. Cherry Street to closed during the Chrome Cruisers Car Show on June 12, 2016. Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Resolution 011-2016 was introduced by Bonzer seconded by James DeWitt: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MOVE OF CITY HALL. The principal office of the City of Shell Rock, Iowa and City Hall will be located at 802 North Public Road, Shell Rock, Iowa. The mailing address of the City shall remain PO Box 522, Shell Rock, Iowa, 50670. Roll Call Vote: Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried.

Resolution 012-2016 was introduced by Benjamin DeWitt seconded by Bonzer: A RESOLUTION SETTING EMPLOYEE WAGES: Library Aide \$8.00 per hour. Roll Call Vote: Ayes-Bonzer, B. DeWitt, J. DeWitt, Klinefelter, and Meyer. Nays-None. Motion carried.
