### CITY OF SHELL ROCK OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES

The operation of snowmobiles in the city limits of Shell Rock is allowed under limited circumstances. Operation is limited to 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Operation on Cherry Street from Railroad to North Public Road is prohibited except of the block of the bridge (to cross the Shell Rock River). The only other exception is to make a direct 90 degree crossing of Cherry Street.

Operation on public property is prohibited. This means snowmobiles may not be operated on any of the school property and any parks. Operating on alleys is prohibited unless the alley leads to the owner's residence in that block. Operating on sidewalks is prohibited. Operating on private property without the owner's consent is prohibited. Operating on the parking (which is the area along the street) is prohibited. This means snowmobiles may not ride up and down the snowbanks along the street created by snowplows. Snowmobiles must obey all traffic rules including stop signs and speed limits.

Very few cities allow snowmobiles to be operated in town. Snowmobilers must follow the rules of operation to reduce the complaints about snowmobile operation and to keep the privilege of operating in town.

Contact Police Chief Lou Staudt, at 885-4434 for your 2018 sticker. The Chief is usually in his office from 1-2:30 on the weekdays.



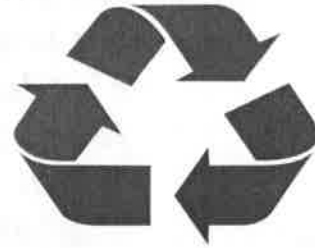
## Scam Alert
