CITY ELECTION PAPERS AVAILABLE

There is an upcoming city election on November 5, 2019. The Mayor's seat and three Council seats are up for election. If you are an eligible elector and would like to run for either Mayor or Council, nomination papers are available at City Hall. The filing period for candidates runs from August 26th through September 19 at 5:00 p.m.

TREE LIMB CLEAN UP POLICY

The City will provide the service of chipping of tree limbs and trees under the following circumstances:

1. Tree limbs removed by property owners in light tree trimming and light storm damage (limbs not to exceed 6 inches in diameter);
2. Trees used for seasonal interior decoration (i.e. Christmas trees);
3. Trees removed from City parking along streets (not alleys). All such removal of trees must be done with approval of the Tree Board under Chapter 151 of the City Code.

The City shall not provide the service of chipping of tree limbs and trees under the following circumstances:

1. Branches or trunks from any tree not on city property larger than 6 inches in diameter, whether removed by the property owner or by a tree service.

Limbs and trees set out for chipping shall be set cut edge to the road on the street side of the property (not the alley side) on or near the parking, in single file (perpendicular) or bundled with string or twine. Bundles may be no more than 10 inches in diameter, and no more than 12 bundles or 12 single limbs may be set out at a time.
